

History of Boys State

A Brief History of Boys State

Within the Commonwealth of Virginia, for one week each year, a new state comes into being. The physical boundaries of this state are the limits of the Liberty University campus, but there are no limits to its usefulness in promoting real life citizenship.

The youth movement known as Boys State was originally sponsored by the American Legion to counteract Pioneer Camps which were being conducted in the United States by the Nazi Freedom Foundation. Pioneer Camps taught that although the democratic form of government had served its purpose well, it was outdated and should be overthrown and replaced by a fascist form of government. Legionnaires in Illinois decided to organize schools to teach youth the American way of life--AMERICANISM. They believed that youth knew the rights and privileges they enjoy under our form of government, they would never support any "ism" except Americanism.

The Americanism Committee of the American Legion of Illinois obtained use of the State Fairgrounds a week in June, 1935. Volunteer American Legion counselors assembled at the Fairgrounds to clean and disinfect cattle stalls, set up borrowed bunks, arrange meeting rooms, purchase food, and set up a field kitchen borrowed from the National Guard.


They had contacted all high school principals of their state and asked them to select their junior class leaders to attend the new government school to study the Constitution and government of the State of Illinois. 235 high school leaders arrived to participate in the government school. During that week, delegates were asked to suggest a suitable name for the program. The name BOYS STATE was suggested by one of the delegates and unanimously adopted.

Other states followed Illinois in organizing Boys State programs. In 1939, The American Legion Department of Virginia, with the cooperation of VPI, organized the Old Dominion Boys State. The program was not held during the war years 1942-1945. Since 1956, the official name of the program has been THE AMERICAN LEGION BOYS STATE OF VIRGINIA, INC. It currently meets each June on the campus of Liberty University.

The program of training has been developed on the assumption that youth can best learn by doing. The mechanics of government are patterned after those actually used in local and state government in Virginia. Boys State is a true democracy in that all of its citizens may vote and are eligible to hold office. It aims at all times to make its program of training in citizenship effective by creating a wide range of opportunities for participation in all forms of government.

The danger of Nazism no longer exists in today's world. Yet, our way of life is still threatened by forms of government alien to our democratic ideas as well as by apathy among our own citizens. The American Legion continues to sponsor Boys State in the belief that young citizens who are familiar with the operation of our form of government will be better prepared to uphold its ideals.
















Curt Dickinson



EDDIE DENTZ



Edwin "Eddie" Dentz tried to join the Naval Air Force while attending George Washington University. His eyesight prevented his acceptance. He stayed in school through the Army Specialized Training Program, entering the program with thirteen weeks of Basic Training at Fort McClellan, Alabama.

Eddie was sent to Alabama Polytechnic Institute, now known as Auburn University, to study engineering. Graduates of the ASTP program would then go to Officer Candidate School; however D-Day changed Eddie's career path and he was shipped to the newly formed 106th Infantry Division at Camp Atterbury, Indiana. He was then sent to England. The 106th then moved to replace the 2nd Division on the Siegried Line in the Ardennes, and soon became involved in the Battle of the Bulge. His platoon found a way through the Seventh Panzer Division and escaped to Liege, Belgium. His unit was part of the only 162 members of the 443rd Regiment who escaped from the encirclement. Eddie was awarded the Bronze Star meal and the Combat Infantry Badge for his actions in combat.

After his military service, he resumed his studies at George Washington University where he received a law degree. He was employed as an attorney for the U.S. Department of Justice.

In 1955, along, with eleven veterans of World War II, formed the Springfield American Legion Post 176. He served as its first commander and over the next fifty-four years served in most elected and appointed positions in the Post. He continued to serve the American Legion and over the years served as 17th District Commander. He served in many Departmental level positions including Commander, Department of Virginia. He went on the serve on the American Legion National Executive Committee. He also served as the Chairman of the National Legislative Committee.

He was a member of the Bull Run Voiture 380, of the Society of 40 and 8.

He had a love for Virginia American Legion Boys State. He worked for more than 25 years in the program. He served as a city counselor, Assistant Director, and for two years was Acting Director. In 2000, he was inducted into the Boys State Hall of Fame.

Those who knew Eddie will always remember his smile and his gracious manner.
